The Bauercrest Foundation volunteers have spent the last 18 months assisting Bauercrest directly with fundraising efforts and assisting camp administration on how the Foundation can support their efforts during a challenging time. We utilized appreciated assets within our endowment to provide both a \$10,000 donation (as part of the camp honor board campaign) and to purchase new bleachers for the Bauercrest A-Diamond.

We have reached out to our community reiterating our mission, as we are Camp Bauercrest's endowment and are a separate entity focusing on the **long-term viability and vision for camp**. In addition to growing the endowment for long term financial security, we provide capital to Bauercrest to fulfill needs outside of their annual budget and fundraising initiatives!
